

"Holidays in My Sakartvelo (Georgia)" May 31st to June 10th, 2024.

Day 1 (May 31st): Lunch at Café Litera followed by a walking tour of Tbilisi and dinner at restaurant Chveni.

Day 2 (June 1st): Visit Kakheti region, including stops at Qvevri maker's family, wine tasting at Rtoni winery, visit to Ikalto monastery, and check-in at Vazisubani Estate.

Day 3 (June 2nd): Culinary masterclasses, wine tasting at Papari valley, and dinner at Vaziubani Estate.

Day 4 (June 3rd): Visit Kardanakhi Estate and Pheasant's Tears winery, then return to Tbilisi with free time for activities like the marionette theater and dinner at Arkivi.

Day 5 (June 4th): Travel to Stepantsminda, with stops at Jinvali Reservoir and Ananuri citadel, lunch on the way, and dinner at Rooms Kazbegi Hotel.

Day 6 (June 5th): Visit Gergeti Trinity Church, Khinkali masterclasses, and overnight at Mtserlebi Resort in Kvishkheti village.

Day 7 (June 6th): Journey to Racha, with stops at Stalin's museum in Gori city and Oni Synagogue, then dinner and overnight at Manino Utsera Hotel.

Day 8 (June 7th): Visit Aleko Sardanashvili, wine tasting, lunch, and a visit to Nikortsminda cathedral before heading to Kutaisi for overnight stay at Best Western Kutaisi.

Day 9 (June 8th): Visit Samegrelo region, Martvili canyons, lunch and wine tasting at Oda family wine cellar, visit Prometheus speleological cave, and overnight in Kutaisi.

Day 10 (June 9th): Return to Tbilisi, visit Baia's family wine cellar, lunch, Uplistsikhe cave town, dinner at a local restaurant, and overnight at Tbilisi Marriott Hotel.

Day 11 (June 10th): Departure to Tbilisi International Airport.

The trip includes cultural experiences, wine tastings, visits to historical sites, and opportunities to explore Georgia's diverse regions.
